Agenda items:

1) Lanthanum: Under the name of Phoslock or Eutrosorb the RLA will begin a program of applying Lanthanum to the lake. Start date 4/29/24. The purpose is to remove substantial amounts of phosphorous from the water column to inhibit the overgrowth of invasive weeds and harmful algae.

Marty presented a briefing summarizing the treatment details.
